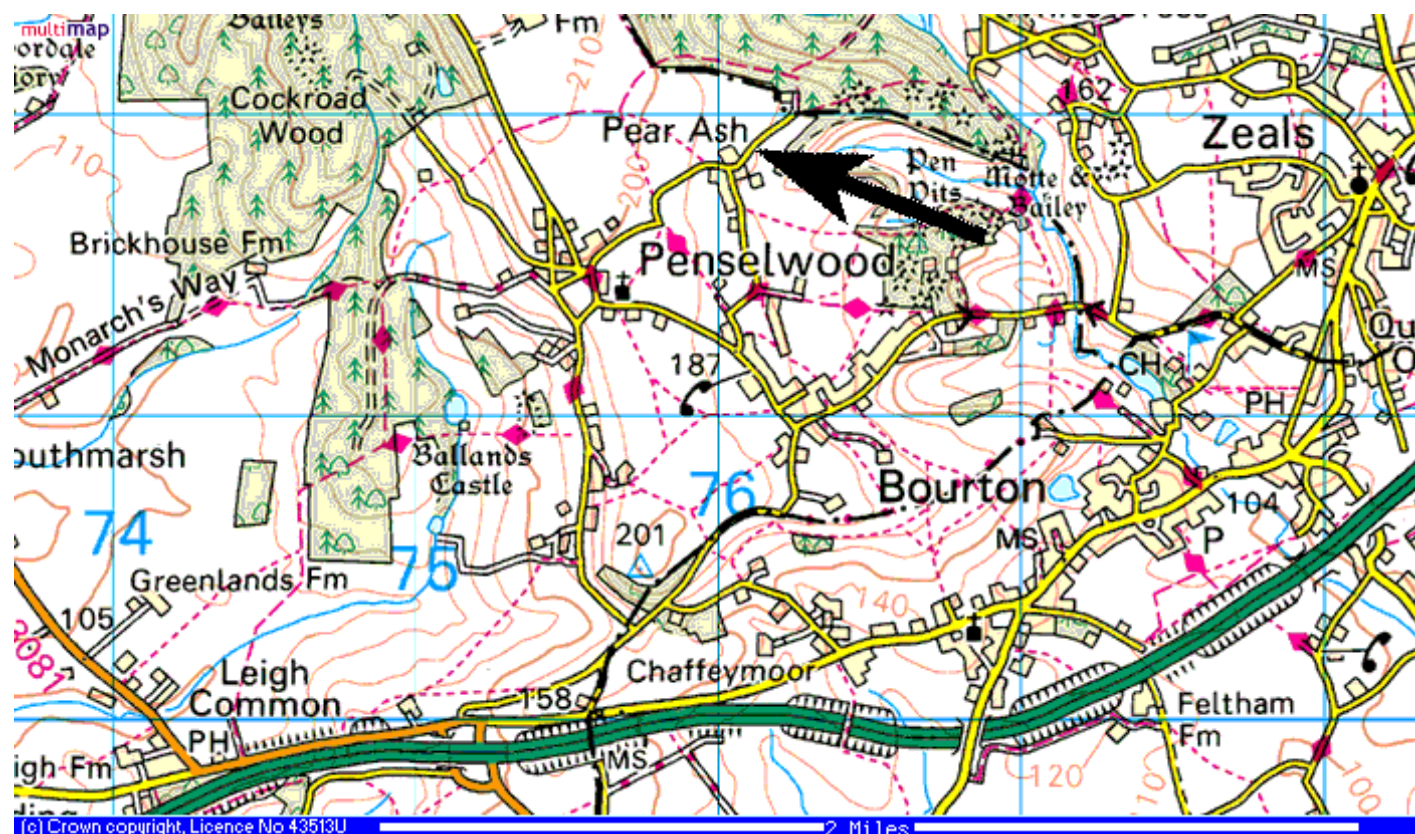

The shoot location will be signed from both eastbound and westbound directions from the A303 at the Tinker's Hill junction between Mere and Wincanton (signed to Bruton)

Please drive slowly along Pear Ash Lane, which is only a single carriageway.

Closing date for entries: Tuesday 28th May 2024. Archers withdrawing before the closing date will be refunded their entry fee(s) less £3.00. No refunds after the closing date.

A target list will be issued in the week preceding the tournament. Results will be sent by email and published online at: [Open Shoots - Ballands Bowmen](#) and on the GB & NI Field Archery Facebook page.

In line with the recommendation in the Archery GB Safeguarding Children and Young People Policy, anyone wishing to take photographs at this event must register with the Tournament Organiser on arrival. No unauthorised photography will be permitted. Please note that in line with the Photographing & Filming Children & Young People in Sport policy, you may be required to obtain written permission from the subject and/or their parents/carers to publish images on the internet or in print.

In accordance with World Archery rules, searches for lost arrows must not delay shooting groups. Please report all lost arrows to the tournament organiser each day, upon completion of scoring.

Ballands Bowmen medals will be awarded for two days' shooting to the highest placed archers at the Tournament Organiser's discretion. Medals will be awarded in all categories according to the number of entries. 2 – 3 entries = 1 medal, 4 – 7 entries = 2 medals, 8 or more entries = 3 medals. Medals will be awarded on the Sunday as soon as possible after shooting finishes.

Ample car parking is available on site. Camping and overnight parking for camper vans may be available: please contact the TO for further details.

Warm-up targets will be available from 8.30am both days.

For junior entries we request that you email the Tournament Organiser to confirm shooting group arrangements. Juniors will only be assigned to a shooting group with their parent, a nominated guardian or fellow club member.
